WHAT IS IT?

The Central Illinois Community Solar System is the most complete large-scale model of the Solar System in the world. The scale factor is 99,000,000:1. In addition to the Sun and 8 planets, the model also includes 5 dwarf planets, and numerous unnamed comets spread across the globe.

The Sun is depicted on the Sun Plaza (46' diameter), laid in red and yellow bricks, and on the wall of the planetarium lobby. The Earth (5" diameter) is nearly one mile from the Museum along the riverfront trail. The most distant yet-discovered dwarf planet, Eris (0.9" diameter), is 62 miles away from the museum, at Western Illinois University.

Unnamed comet plaques are located on all seven continents, stretching as far north as Barrow, Alaska, and as far south as South Pole Station, Antarctica. In the United States, unnamed comets can be found in Alaska, California, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nevada, New Hampshire, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Texas, Virginia, Washington, Washington D.C., and Wisconsin.

Outside the USA, unnamed comet plaques can be found in Argentina, Australia, Chile, China, Denmark, Ecuador, Germany, Japan, Norway, Russia, South Pole Station of Antarctica, and Swaziland.
